

# DEPARTMENT 17 - HANDWORK

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## Requirements for Entering:

1. Exhibitors must read and comply with all **Fair Rules and Regulations**, located on page 4, for participation in the Woodstock Fair.
2. A maximum of 15 finished articles, plus one additional article for the special contest, will be accepted per exhibitor.
3. A maximum of 6 articles per lot within a class will be accepted. One class per item, determined by exhibitor.
4. Classes A thru I must be crafted by hand (without machine, with the exception of Class B, Lot 24) completely by the exhibitor. No work is to be finished by someone else.
5. **2021 Only:** All articles must have been completed within the last 2 years.
6. Item must be clean and unused. Soiled or worn items will receive "no placement".
7. Visible names or labels must be covered.
8. Framed entries must be ready for hanging on a sturdy hanger with wire; no clips. No exceptions.
9. In needlework classes, the area of stitched work is measured. ***If less than 6" and entering more than one article, must be entered as a group of items as only one per exhibitor.***
10. Due to space limitations, large items may be restricted.
11. Judging will be by the Danish System, except where otherwise stated.

**Please note:** Department 17, Classes SC - L, is open to amateur exhibitors only, exhibitors who craft for pleasure, not resale. Exhibitors who sell their crafts are not eligible to enter in Classes SC - L.

Professional Exhibitors may enter any handwork in Class M: Professional

## STATE QUILT CONTEST Association of Connecticut Fairs

**How to Enter:** Enter a quilt at any participating fair that is a member of the Association of Connecticut Fairs in any of the categories mentioned below.

The participating fair will award one winner in each category with a rosette from the Association of Connecticut Fairs along with any awards the local fair provides. Each fair will submit that winning entry to the state contest. A quilt can be entered in as many fairs as the contestant wishes until it becomes eligible to go to the state contest.

**State Quilt Contest:** Once a quilt has won the State Quilt ribbon at a participating fair, it is eligible to be entered into the State Quilt Contest. Each fair must preregister their local winner. The local fair will provide contest information to the winner. Visit [www.ctagfairs.org](http://www.ctagfairs.org) for the latest information. One reservation for the winning exhibitor will be made compliments of the Woodstock Agricultural Society, Inc. Additional reservations will be at the exhibitor's expense.

The following prizes will be awarded in each category:

**1st Prize:** \$100.00 for Hand- Appliqué and Hand Pieced Quilt  
Sponsored by the Mayflower Society  
\$100.00 Machine Pieced Quilt

**2nd Prize:** 35.00      **3rd Prize:** 15.00      **People's Choice Award:** 50.00

**Categories:**

1. Hand-Appliqué
2. Patchwork - Machine Quilted
3. Patchwork - Hand Quilted

**Adult Quilt Contest Rules:**

1. This contest is open to all residents of Connecticut.
2. All work must be completed by an individual quilt maker.
3. Work can be pieced by hand or by machine but appliqué must be done by hand.
4. Quilts must be either hand or machine quilted, no hand tied quilts.
5. Quilts may not be made from pre-cut quilt kits.
6. An exhibitor can only represent 1 quilt per category in the Association of CT Fairs Quilt contest. A quilt may only compete once.
7. Appliqué quilts must consist of at least 50% appliqué.
8. Quilt perimeter must measure a minimum of 216 inches total.
9. No wall hanging quilts.
