Requirements for Entering:

1. Exhibitors must read and comply with all **Fair Rules and Regulations**, located on page 4, for participation in the Woodstock Fair.
2. In any lot, an exhibitor may place only one entry, with the exception of lots 27, 36, 51, 66 and 77.
3. For "named" entries, bring the name with you so it can be noted, ex. "The Fairy Rose". If the variety name is unknown enter the flowers under "unnamed".
4. For "identified" entries, write the common name of the plant on the entry form ex. "Bush Clover".
5. All flowers must be grown by exhibitor. No commercially grown cut flowers may be used.
6. Specimens entered must have flowers. While the flowers are the primary part judged, all plant parts (flowers, stems, buds, leaves) must be disease free and without insect damage.
7. Glass containers must be used - their weight helps prevent tipping.
8. Artificial or silk flowers may not be used in any of the classes.
9. To keep the displays looking fresh, superintendents, at their discretion, may dispose of some blossoms and/or add water and floral preservative.
10. Best in Show Award - the overall best in **all** categories. This will be judged by all the judges to select one Best in Show. The winner will receive an additional ribbon as well as a \$10 premium.
11. Judging will be by the Danish System except where otherwise stated.

CLASS A Tiered Trays

1. Tiered Trays are the current rage for home decorating! Use 6 or more kinds of plant material to style your multilevel tray. For tier tray ideas search the web, especially Pinterest. Having theme in mind will help you coordinate all the materials. Floral material and overall design of the tray will be judged.

CLASS B WATERING CAN ARRANGEMENT

2. Create an arrangement in a watertight METAL watering can (no plastic cans will be accepted).
 - Container must be no larger than 15" across, including spout.
 - Arrangement should be 80% plant material.

5 to 8 stems per collection, may be different varieties/colors, without different foliage added. Branching stems count as 1 stem.

**CLASS H
ARRANGEMENTS**

*Arrangement of fresh cut, home grown flowers (no artificial)
judged by artistic arrangement, attractiveness and quality.*

PREMIUMS: 1st 8.00 2nd 7.00 3rd 6.00

Lot No. Description

- 53. Arrangement in a single boot or pair of boots. Must have a water tight container on the inside to hold the arrangement.
- 54. Arrangement made of all edible plants. **Maximum height 24"**.
- 55. Arrangement in a mason jar. Small, medium or large mason jars will be accepted.
- 56. Mini arrangement. **Overall height including container, 5" or less.**
- 57. Tricolor arrangement in a Basket. Use a 3 color scheme to create your arrangement.
- 58. Arrangement in a wood box. Place a water tight container in the box.
- 59. Monochromatic arrangement, **named. Also use a container that is the same color as the flowers in the arrangement. Maximum height 24"**.
- 60. Creative Arrangement
2022 theme "Kitchen Kreation"
Cook up an arrangement using a common kitchen vessel as a container, ex. mixing bowl, pitcher.

Plants must be insect and disease free. Diameter of pot must not exceed 16".


